Semiahmoo Minor Lacrosse Association (SMLA) is a volunteer non-profit organization which administrates minor lacrosse for residents of the South Surrey and White Rock communities on the Semiahmoo Peninsula. Consistent with its mission to enhance the minor lacrosse experience to the fullest extent possible, SMLA has adopted a risk management program aimed at providing children with the safest and most secure playing environment possible. As part of this program, and pursuant to British Columbia Minor Lacrosse Association (BCALA) Harassment and Sexual Abuse Policies, SMLA requires all volunteers, including coaches, managers, executive members and other who are involved with or responsible for children, to agree to have suitable background checks conducted by Surrey or White Rock RCM Police.

Having completed (i) 'Consent for Disclosure of Criminal Record Information Category 4 (RCMP GRC 3584 FLO)' and (ii) 'Consent for a Criminal Record Check for a Sexual Offence for which a Pardon has been Granted or Issued (RCMP GRC MD185 ICS)', the adult volunteer applicant who has attended your Detachment with this letter and suitable identification in hand agrees to all required background checks being conducted.

As these background checks are required for a volunteer position, SMLA understands that processing or administrative fees normally associated with this service are waived by your Detachment. If this is not the case, any fees charged are payable by the volunteer applicant who will then seek reimbursement from SMLA (NB: receipt required).

All information received as a result of the foregoing will be treated confidentially by SMLA. It is requested that results of completed background checks be delivered directly to the undersigned since results delivered or communicated by volunteer applicants will be considered invalid.
